THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW YORK RESOLUTION NO. 926

Resolution approving the decision of the City Planning Commission on an application submitted by the Department of Housing Preservation and Development, ULURP No. C 050072 HAM, approving the designation of 435, 437 and 439 East 119th Street (Block 1807/Lots 15 and 16), Manhattan, as an Urban Development Action Area, approving the project for the area as an Urban Development Action Area Project, and approving the disposition of such property to a developer selected by the Department of Housing Preservation and Development (L.U. No. 320; C 050072 HAM).

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission filed with the Council on March 11, 2005 its decision dated March 2, 2005 (the "Decision"), on the application submitted by the Department of Housing Preservation and Development pursuant to Section 197-c of the New York City Charter and Article 16 of the General Municipal Law of New York State regarding:

- a) the designation of property located at 435, 437 and 439 East 119th Street (Block 1807/Lots 15 and 16), as an Urban Development Action Area (the "Area");
- b) an Urban Development Action Area Project for such area (the "Project"); and

pursuant to Section 197-c of the New York City Charter for the disposition of such property to a developer selected by the Department of Housing Preservation and Development to facilitate development of a seven-story building, tentatively known as Project GreenHope, an adult residential facility funded by the New York State Homeless Housing Assistance Program (the "Disposition"), Community District 11, Borough of Manhattan (ULURP No. C 050072 HAM) (the "Application");

WHEREAS, the Application is related to ULURP Application Number C 050073 ZSM (L.U. No. 321), a special permit pursuant to Section 74-902 of the Zoning Resolution;

WHEREAS, the Decision is subject to review and action by the Council pursuant to Section 197-d(b)(1) of the City Charter;

WHEREAS, the Application and Decision are subject to review and action by the Council pursuant to Article 16 of the General Municipal Law of New York State;

WHEREAS, the New York City Department of Housing Preservation and Development ("HPD") submitted to the Council its recommendations regarding the Application on March 24, 2005;

WHEREAS, upon due notice, the Council held a public hearing on the Application and Decision on April 4, 2005;

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the relevant environmental review (CEQR No. 03HPD006M) and the fact that a negative declaration was issued on August 17, 2004;

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the land use and financial implications and other policy issues relating to the Application;

RESOLVED:

The Council finds that the actions described herein will have no significant effect on the environment;

Pursuant to Section 197-d, the Council approves the decision of the City Planning Commission (C 050072 HAM).

The Council finds that the present status of the Disposition Area tends to impair or arrest the sound growth and development of the City of New York and that a designation of the Project as an urban development action area project is consistent with the policy and purposes stated in Section 691 of the General Municipal Law.

The Council approves the designation of the Disposition Area as an urban development action area pursuant to Section 693 of the General Municipal Law.

The Council approves the Project as an urban development action area project pursuant to Section 694 of the General Municipal Law.

The Council approves the disposition of said property to a developer selected by the Department of Housing Preservation and Development.
