THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW YORK RESOLUTION NO. 1052

Resolution approving the petition for a revocable consent for an unenclosed sidewalk café located at 4292 Katonah Avenue, the Bronx (20055499 TCX; L.U. No. 500).

WHEREAS, the Department of Consumer Affairs filed with the Council on June 1, 2005 its approval of the petition of Rambling House, Inc., for a revocable consent to establish, maintain and operate an unenclosed sidewalk café located at 4292 Katonah Avenue, Community District 12, Borough of the Bronx (the "Petition"), pursuant to Section 20-226 of the New York City Administrative Code (the "Administrative Code");

WHEREAS, the Petition is subject to review by the Council pursuant to Section 20-226(g) of the Administrative Code;

WHEREAS, upon due notice, the Council held a public hearing on the Petition on June 15, 2005; and

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the land use implications and other policy issues relating to the Petition;
