THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW YORK RESOLUTION NO. 1108

Resolution approving the motion to file pursuant to withdrawal of the petition for a revocable consent for an unenclosed sidewalk café located at 50 Gansevoort Street, Manhattan (20055545 TCM; L.U. No. 513).

WHEREAS, the Department of Consumer Affairs filed with the Council on June 14, 2005 its approval of the petition of PM Operating Group, LLC, d/b/a PM Lounge (the "Applicant"), for a revocable consent to establish, maintain and operate an unenclosed sidewalk café located at 50 Gansevoort Street, Borough of Manhattan (the "Petition"), pursuant to Section 20-226 of the New York City Administrative Code (the "Administrative Code");
