Resolution approving the petition for a revocable consent for an unenclosed small sidewalk café located at 224 Lafayette Street, Manhattan (20065018 TCM; L.U. No. 622).

WHEREAS, the Department of Consumer Affairs filed with the Council on October 24,2005 its approval dated October 24, 2005 of the petition of H & A Café Corp., d/b/a Midnight Café (the "Applicant"), for a revocable consent to establish, maintain and operate an unenclosed small sidewalk café located at 224 Lafayette Street, Community District 2, Borough of Manhattan (the "Petition"), pursuant to Section 20-226 of the New York City Administrative Code (the "Administrative Code");
