State Legislation Resolution No. 95

State Legislation Resolution requesting the New York State Legislature to pass bills introduced by the Senate Committee on Rules, S.5628-A, and Assembly Member Abbate, A.6512-A, “AN ACT to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to allowing members of the police pension fund to obtain retirement credit for certain periods of New York police department cadet corps service”.

Whereas, bills have been introduced in the New York State Legislature by the Senate Committee on Rules, S.5628-A, and Assembly Member Abbate, A.6512-A, “AN ACT to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to allowing members of the police pension fund to obtain retirement credit for certain periods of New York police cadet corps service”; and

Whereas, the enactment of the above State Legislation requires the concurrence of the Council of the City of New York as the local legislative body; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, that the Council of the City of New York, in accordance with the provisions of Section 2 of Article 9 of the Constitution of the State of New York, does hereby request the New York State Legislature to enact into law the aforesaid pending bills.
