## THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW YORK RESOLUTION NO. 1134

Resolution affirming the designation by the Landmarks Preservation Commission of the 486 Greenwich Street House (Block 595, Lot 83), Manhattan, Designation List No. 394, LP-2225 (L.U. No. 590; 20085038 HKM (N 080031 HKM).

WHEREAS, the Landmarks Preservation Commission filed with the Council on August 7, 2007, a copy of its designation dated July 24, 2007 (the "Designation"), of the 486 Greenwich Street House, Community District 2, Borough of Manhattan, as a landmark and Block 595, Lot 83, as its landmark site pursuant to Section 3020 of the New York City Charter;

WHEREAS, the Designation is subject to review by the Council pursuant to Section 3020 of the City Charter;

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission submitted to the Council on September 7, 2007 its report on the Designation dated September 5, 2007 (the "Report");

WHEREAS, upon due notice, the Council held a public hearing on the Designation on October 23, 2007; and

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the land use implications and other policy issues relating to the Designation;

RESOLVED:

Pursuant to Section 3020 of the City Charter, and on the basis of the information and materials contained in the Designation and the Report, the Council affirms the Designation.
