Resolution approving the petition for a revocable consent for an unenclosed sidewalk café located at 205 Allen Street, Borough of Manhattan (20085524 TCM; L.U. No. 864).

WHEREAS, the Department of Consumer Affairs filed with the Council on August 7, 2008 its approval dated August 7, 2008 of the petition of Raynick Corp., d/b/a Móle Mexican Bar and Grill, for a revocable consent to establish, maintain and operate an unenclosed sidewalk café located at 205 Allen Street, Community District 3, Borough of Manhattan (the "Petition"), pursuant to Section 20-226 of the New York City Administrative Code (the "Administrative Code");

WHEREAS, the Petition is subject to review by the Council pursuant to Section 20-226(g) of the Administrative Code;

WHEREAS, upon due notice, the Council held a public hearing on the Petition on September 16, 2008; and
