RESOLUTION NO. 1443

Resolution disapproving the petition for a revocable consent for an unenclosed sidewalk café located at 333 Hudson Street, Manhattan (20005146 TCM; L.U. No. 780).

WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation filed with the Council on May 9, 2000 its approval of the petition of 333 Hudson Food Court, Ltd., d/b/a Hudson Square Food Court, for a revocable consent to continue to maintain and operate an unenclosed sidewalk cafe located at 333 Hudson Street, Borough of Manhattan (the "Petition"), pursuant to Section 20-226 of the New York City Administrative Code (the "Administrative Code");

WHEREAS, the Petition is subject to review by the Council pursuant to Section 20-226(g) of the Administrative Code;

WHEREAS, upon due notice, the Council held a public hearing on the Petition on June 20, 2000; and

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the land use implications and other policy issues relating to the Petition;
