THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW YORK RESOLUTION NO. 1191

Resolution disapproving the petition for a revocable consent for an unenclosed sidewalk café located at 46 Gansevoort Street, Manhattan (20055567 TCM; L.U. No. 585).

WHEREAS, the Department of Consumer Affairs filed with the Council on August 29, 2005 its approval dated August 26, 2005, of the petition of Le Gans Restaurant, Inc. (the "Applicant") for a revocable consent to continue to maintain and operate an unenclosed sidewalk café located at 46 Gansevoort Street, Community District 2, Borough of Manhattan (the "Petition"), pursuant to Section 20-226 of the New York City Administrative Code (the "Administrative Code");

WHEREAS, the Petition is subject to review by the Council pursuant to Section 20-226(g) of the Administrative Code;

WHEREAS, upon due notice, the Council held a public hearing on the Petition on September 20, 2005; and

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the land use implications and other policy issues relating to the Petition;
