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### THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW YORK RESOLUTION NO. 491

Resolution disapproving the petition for a revocable consent for an unenclosed sidewalk café located at 80 University Place, Manhattan (20065509 TCM; L.U. No. 219).

WHEREAS, the Department of Consumer Affairs filed with the Council on July 14, 2006 its approval dated July 14, 2006 of the petition of Ladl LLC, d/b/a Jack, for a revocable consent to establish, maintain and operate an unenclosed sidewalk café located at 80 University Place, Community District 2, Borough of Manhattan (the "Petition"), pursuant to Section 20-226 of the New York City Administrative Code (the "Administrative Code");

WHEREAS, the Petition is subject to review by the Council pursuant to Section 20-226(g) of the Administrative Code;
