A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to requiring the police department's property clerk to look for a claimant's identification in seized property upon request

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Section 14-140 of the administrative code of the city of New York is amended by adding a

new subdivision l to read as follows:

1. Identification. Where a claimant attempts to claim property that is in the custody of the property clerk

but fails to present valid identification as required by rules of the department, the property clerk shall search the property to be claimed for the owner's identification, provided that the claimant first:

1. Presents a voucher for such property issued by the department at the time of seizure; and

2. Asserts that the requisite means of identification is among the property to be claimed and requests that the property clerk search such property for the owner's identification.

§ 2. This local law takes effect immediately.
