Resolution affirming the designation by the Landmarks Preservation Commission of the Brooklyn Union Gas Company Building located at 176 Renssen Street a.k.a. 172-178 Renssen Street (Tax Map Block 255, Lot 36 in part), Borough of Brooklyn, Designation List No. 442, LP-2336 (L.U. No. 432; 20115756 HKK; N 110345 HKK).

WHEREAS, the Landmarks Preservation Commission filed with the Council on May 18, 2011 a copy of its designation dated May 10 , 2011 (the "Designation"), of the Brooklyn Union Gas Company Building located at 176 Renssen Street a.k.a. 172-178 Renssen Street, Community District 2, Borough of Brooklyn, as a landmark, and Tax Map Block 255, Lot 36 in part, as its landmark site pursuant to Section 3020 of the New York City Charter;

WHEREAS, the Designation is subject to review by the Council pursuant to Section 3020 of the City Charter;

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission submitted to the Council on June 24, 2011, its report on the Designation dated June 22, 2011 (the "Report");

WHEREAS, upon due notice, the Council held a public hearing on the Designation on July 25, 2011; and

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the land use implications and other policy issues relating to the Designation;

RESOLVED:

Pursuant to Section 3020 of the City Charter, and on the basis of the information and materials contained in the Designation and the Report, the Council affirms the Designation.
